Medication for Opioid Addiction

Want off Opioids? Medication can help!

Buprenorphine

A partial opioid that treats cravings & prevents withdrawals. (dissolving strip, dissolving tab, long acting injection)

- Pros:
 Highly effective
 Can be helpful for chronic pain
 Decrease risk of overdose and death
 Can fully or partially block other opioids
- Cons: Taste • Constipation possible

Naltrexone

An opioid blocker (pill or long acting injection)

- Pros:
- Non-opioid
- Effective
- Can be given as a once monthly shot
- Can also help decrease alcohol use
- **Cons:** Need to be off opioids for at least 5 days
 - Decreased tolerance

Methadone

A LONG ACTING opioid that treats cravings & prevents withdrawals (pill or liquid)

- **Pros:** Highly effective
 - Can be helpful for chronic pain
 - Decreases risk of overdose and death!
- **Cons:** Frequent clinic visits needed



Is a weekly or monthly buprenorphine injection right for you?

Extended Release Buprenorphine is a once monthly injection of the active ingredient in Suboxone[®] and Subutex[®]


- **Pros:**
- No more worrying about lost or stolen meds
- No more waiting for pills or strips to dissolve
- No more ups and downs throughout the day
- **Cons:** Some pain at site during injection


Worried about the shot wearing off?








How to take Buprenorphine (Suboxone®, Subutex®)








- Do not eat, drink, or smoke right away
- Safely store your medications way from kids
- Do <u>not</u> mix with alcohol, benzos, or other sedating substances
- Let strip fully dissolve
- Don't chew strip
- Brush / rinse off your teeth

Ready to Start Buprenoprine?





** If you don't use every day or use smaller amounts you may want to start slower.



What if I'm Pregnant?

Can I take buprenorphine during pregnancy?

Absolutely! Buprenorphine is considered one of the treatments of choice in pregnant and breastfeeding mothers

Will I need to stop buprenorphine prior to delivery?

No. It is recommended for you to continue your same dose before, during, and after delivery

Can I be treated for pain during delivery?

Yes. You can still get an epidural and pain treatment as needed.

Am I a bad mom for being on medication during pregnancy?

Absolutely not! Getting treatment is one of the best things you can do for your baby!

Want to Stop or Decrease Alcohol Use

Medication may help! Talk to your provider before you abruptly stop drinking.

Naltrexone

Decreases the rewarding effects of alcohol. (Daily pill or long acting injection)

- **Pros:** Can decrease cravings
 - Comes in a once monthly shot
 - Also acts as an opioid blocker
- **Cons:** The shot version can be expensive
 - You can still become intoxicated if you drink

Acamprosate

Helps you feel more balanced off alcohol (Comes as a pill)

- Can help you feel better when you don't drink
 - Can decrease drive to drink
- Cons: Have to take three times daily

Disulfiram

If you drink, you will feel very sick. (Comes as a pill)

- **Pros:** It is a deterrent
- Need to be careful with alcohol in food, perfumes and skin care products.
