School-Based Health Centers (SBHC) make getting medical care simple.

Staffed by Missouri Highlands Health Care Nurse Practitioners, school-based health centers provide a range of services including sick visits, wellness exams and management of chronic conditions, just to name a few. Our purpose is to keep students in school and parents at work. When students aren't feeling well, they have a harder time learning.

What Services Do We Offer? Services can include:

- Wellness checkups. Checkups are essential for a child's growth and health
- Testing for illnesses such as strep, flu, covid, rsv, and mononucleosis
- Sports Physicals
- Checkups and management of chronic conditions, like asthma and diabetes.
- Teaching students about healthy eating and exercise
- Counseling for mental health and emotional issues
- Referrals to specialists, if needed
- Immunizations, with scheduled appointment

School-Based Health Centers are not meant to replace your child's regular doctor. We will work with them to offer consistent care.

How Do We Keep Parents Informed?

School-based health centers work hard to keep parents in the loop about their children's health. You are welcome to join the visit at school (either in person or via telephone). If you are not available, the nurse practitioner will personally call you after the visit to let you know of any findings. If you sign up for a Missouri Highlands Patient Portal, you will also receive a patient care summary after each visit.

How Much Do Services Cost?

Missouri Highlands Health Care will bill your insurance just as your primary care provider does. If you do not have insurance, we offer a sliding fee scale based on family income and household size. We also have Navigators available to help in finding medical insurance and signing up.

How to Sign Up

1. Complete all pages of our Registration Paperwork with signature by the child's parent/legal guardian.
